	 To register in New Jersey, you must be: A United States citizen At least 17 years old, though you may not vote until you have reached the age of 18 A resident of the county for 30 days before the election A person not serving a sentence of incarceration as the result of a conviction of any indictable offense under the laws of this or another state or of the United States. You are not eligible to register to vote if: You are serving a sentence of a conviction of an indictable offense under the laws of this or another state or of the United States. 	New Jersey does not require voters to present identification while voting, in most cases. However, if a voter does not provide valid identification at the time of registration, he or she must show identification at the polling place. Voters can present the following forms of identification: • New Jersey driver's license • Military or other government ID • Student or job ID • Store membership card • United States Passport, • Bank statement • Car registration • Government check or document • Non-photo NJ driver's license • Rent receipt • Sample Ballot • Utility bill • Any other official document
