	<ul> <li>To register to vote in Hawaii, you must be:</li> <li>A U.S. Citizen (Non-U.S. citizens, including U.S. nationals do not qualify.)</li> <li>A Resident of the State of Hawaii (Residency cannot simply be because of the applicant's presence in the state, but that residency was acquired with the intent to make Hawaii the person's legal residence with all the accompanying obligation therein.)</li> <li>At least eighteen (18) years of age (Hawaii law allows eligible individuals to pre-register at 16 years of age and upon reaching 18 years of age will automatically be registered to vote and mailed a ballot.)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Voters in Hawaii are not generally required to present identification while voting. In 2019, the statute requiring voters to present identification if so requested by a precinct official was repealed.</li> <li>When registering to vote for the first time, a Hawaii Driver License, Hawaii State ID, or the last 4-digits of the voter's Social Security Number is required.</li> <li>If none of these can be provided, one of the following must be provided as proof of identification: <ul> <li>A current and valid photo identification; or</li> <li>A current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
