<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>September 13, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.</p>	<p>To register to vote in Rhode Island, an applicant must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Rhode Island, and at least 16 years old.</p> <p>Prospective voters must be at least 18 years old by the day of the election to vote.</p> <p>The deadline to register to vote is 30 days prior to an election. Applicants can register online, by mailing in a voter registration form, or in person at the local board of canvassers, the board of elections, or other state agencies.</p>	<p>Rhode Island requires voters to present photo identification while voting.</p> <p>Voters can present the following forms of identification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Rhode Island driver's license/permit</li><li>● U.S. passport</li><li>● ID card issued by any federally recognized tribal government</li><li>● ID card issued by an educational institution in the United States</li><li>● U.S. military identification card</li><li>● ID card issued by the U.S. government or Rhode Island</li><li>● Government-issued medical card</li><li>● Rhode Island Voter ID card</li></ul> <p>Voters without a photo ID can obtain one for free from the Rhode Island</p> <p>Department of State. In order to receive a voter ID card, the voter must provide one of the following proofs of identity: Employee ID card, ID card provided by a commercial establishment, Credit or debit card, Military ID card and Student ID card</p>
