	 To register to vote in Delaware, one must: be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Delaware (Delaware is your home), and will be 18 years old on or before the date of the next General Election. One may not register to vote in Delaware if: they have been adjudged mentally incompetent. If the potential voter has been convicted of a felony and has not fully discharged the requirements of the sentence or were convicted of a disqualifying felony and have not been pardoned, that individual may not register to vote in Delaware. 	 Delaware requires voters to present non-photo identification (ID) while voting. Accepted forms of ID include: Delaware driver's licenses, U.S. passports, and signed polling place cards. Voters who do not have ID while voting may "sign an affidavit or affirmation that the voter is the person listed on the election district record.
