<p>On April 6, 2021, Governor Mark Gordon signed HB0075 into law, establishing a photo identification requirement for voters in Wyoming.</p> <p>Under the law, acceptable forms of identification include valid forms of photo identification issued by a state, tribal or federal government, a Wyoming higher educational institution or public school, and Medicare and Medicaid insurance cards.</p> <p>Voters who cannot present acceptable identification are permitted to cast provisional ballots.</p> <p>The Department of Transportation is required to waive the fee on identification cards used solely for the purpose of voter identification.</p> <p>Statewide election dates August 16, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.</p>	<p>To vote in Wyoming, one must be a United States citizen, a resident of Wyoming, and at least 18 years of age.</p> <p>The registration deadline is 15 days before the election. There are three ways to register to vote in Wyoming.</p> <p>One may register in person at the office of the county or town clerk.</p> <p>One may also mail the completed form to the county clerk.</p> <p>Voters can also register at the polls on Election Day.</p>	<p>Wyoming requires voters to present identification when voting.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2021:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A Wyoming driver's license as defined by W.S. 31-7-102(a)(xxv)2. A tribal identification card issued by the governing body of the Eastern Shoshone tribe of Wyoming, the Northern Arapaho tribe of Wyoming or other federally recognized Indian tribe3. A Wyoming identification card4. A valid United States passport5. A United States military card;6. A driver's license or identification card issued by any state or outlying possession of the United States7. Photo identification issued by the University of Wyoming, a Wyoming community college or a Wyoming public school8. A valid Medicare insurance card. This subdivision is repealed effective December 31, 20299. A valid Medicaid insurance card. This subdivision is repealed effective December 31, 2029.
