<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>August 2, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.</p>	<p>To vote in Missouri, one must be 18 years old, a United States citizen, and Missouri resident.</p> <p>An applicant may print an application, pick one up from a county clerk's office, or request that an application be mailed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The completed application must be returned by mail. All returned applications must be postmarked at least 27 days prior to Election Day in order to be processed. <p>An applicant may also register to vote online.</p>	<p>Missouri requires voters to present identification while voting. Identification with or without a photo can be used.</p> <p>The following were accepted forms of identification as of October 2019.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Non Expired Missouri driver's license• Non Expired or non expiring Missouri non-driver license• Non Expired or non expiring military ID card with a photograph• Identification issued by Missouri governments• Identification issued by the United States government• ID issued by an institution of higher education• Copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or other government document that contains the name and address of the voter• If a voter does not have an ID, he or she can obtain one for free
