VOTER ID LAWS

You must meet the following qualifications to register to vote:

- Age
 - To register to vote you must be 18 years old.
 - If you are 17 years old and will be 18 by the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November of this year, you can register.
- Residence

To register, you must be resident of Nebraska and of the county where you are registering. If you move to another county, you must re-register.

- Citizenship
 You must be a United States citizen in order to register to vote.
- Felony Conviction
 If you have been convicted of a felony, either in Nebraska or another state or in federal court, you cannot register to vote until two years after the completion of your sentence including any probation or parole term.
- Mentally Incompetent (Non compos mentis)
 If you have been found by a court to be mentally incompetent, you cannot register to vote.

On June 1, 2023, the Governor signed into law LB514, which establishes voter identification (ID) requirements for elections in Nebraska.

All special and statewide elections after this date will require voter ID. No special election prior to May 14, 2024 will require voter ID.
