	Voter Registration requirements in Georgia	Georgia law requires photo identification when voting, either in person or absentee.
	 To register to vote you must be: A citizen of the United States. A legal resident of Georgia and of the county in which you wish to vote. At least 17 1/2 years of age to register and 18 to vote. You may NOT register to vote if you are currently: Serving a sentence for a felony. Have been ruled determined mentally incompetent by a court. 	 absentee. Seven forms of identification to vote in person: Any valid state or federal government-issued photo ID, including free ID card issued by your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services. A Georgia driver's license, even if expired Student ID from a Georgia public College or University Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, of entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state Valid U.S. passport ID Valid U.S. military photo ID containing a photograph of the voter Valid tribal photo ID containing a photograph of the voter
