	You are eligible to vote in District of Columbia if you: • Are a U.S. citizen • Are a resident of District of Columbia • Are at least 18 years old by Election Day You must live in district at least 30 days to be eligible to vote. After a 2020 change, people who are incarcerated for any reason can now always vote in Washington, D.C.	Forms of accepted ID Washington, D.C. does not require identification from most voters. The D.C. Board of Elections requires voters who submitted their registration applications online or by mail to present one of the following documents the first time they vote. Acceptable forms of proof of residence include the following (must include the name and address of the voter): Valid District of Columbia DMV-issued ID Government check or paycheck Bank statement Current utility bill (does not include cell phone) Student housing statement/tuition bill Homeless shelter occupancy statement Residential Lease Other current government document that shows your name and address *The issue, bill, or statement date must be within 90 days of Election Day
