	To register in Colorado you must: • be a citizen of the United States • be a resident of Colorado for at least 22 days immediately before the election in which you intend to vote • be at least 16 years old, but must be at least eighteen on or before election day to be eligible to vote • not be serving a sentence of detention or confinement for a felony conviction	 Colorado requires voters to present non-photo identification when voting in person. If voting by mail for the first time, a voter may also need to return a photocopy of his or her identification with his or her mail-in ballot. The following documents are among the acceptable forms of identification: A valid Colorado driver's license or valid identification card issued by the Colorado Department of Revenue A valid U.S. passport. A valid employee identification card with a photograph A valid U.S. military identification card with a photograph A copy of a current (within the last 60 days) utility bill, bank statement, showing the name and address. A Certificate of Degree of Indian or Alaskan Native Blood. A valid Medicare or Medicaid card A certified copy of a U.S. birth certificate Documentation of naturalization. A valid student ID with a photograph. A valid veteran identification A valid card certifying tribal membership.
