<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>August 4, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: Varies by county</p>	<p>To register to vote in Tennessee, an applicant must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Tennessee, and at least 18 years old by the day of the next election.</p> <p>Prospective voters can register online, by mailing a voter registration application to the county election commission, or in person at a variety of locations including the county clerk's office, the county election commission office, public libraries, and numerous state agencies.</p> <p>Registration must be completed 30 days before an election.</p>	<p>Tennessee requires voters to present photo identification while voting.</p> <p>Voters can present the following forms of identification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Tennessee driver's license with photo● United States passport● Photo ID issued by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security● Photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government● United States Military photo ID● Tennessee handgun carry permit with photo <p>The following voters are exempt from the photo ID requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Voters who vote absentee by mail● Voters who are residents of a licensed nursing home or assisted living center and who vote at the facility● Voters who are hospitalized● Voters with a religious objection to being photographed● Voters who are indigent and unable to obtain a photo ID without paying a fee
