<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>August 2, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: Poll opening hours vary; close at 8 p.m. (most voting done by mail)</p>	<p>To vote in Washington, one must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Washington, and at least 18 years of age.</p> <p>One may register to vote online, by mail, or in-person at a county elections department. Registration must be completed eight days in advance if done by mail or online. In-person registration is available through Election Day.</p> <p>In 2018, Washington lawmakers adopted legislation providing for same-day voter registration and automatic voter registration beginning in 2019.</p>	<p>Washington requires voters to present photo identification while voting in person. However, most voters in Washington vote by mail.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of November 2019.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Driver's license● State identification card● Student identification card● Tribal identification card● Employer identification card
