	<p>To vote you must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A U.S. citizen</li><li>• At least 18 years old on Election Day</li><li>• A resident of Minnesota for 20 days</li><li>• Not currently incarcerated for a felony conviction (<a href="#">More info</a>)</li></ul> <p>You can vote while <u>under guardianship</u> unless a judge specifically has revoked your right to vote.</p> <p>You cannot vote if a court has ruled that you are legally incompetent.</p>	<p>Identification is not required of already-registered voters in Minnesota. If they have not voted in four years or more, proof of residence is required.</p> <p>To register at your polling place on Election Day, bring one proof of residence listed below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ID with current name and address</li><li>• Valid Minnesota driver's license, learner's permit or ID; or a receipt for any of these.</li><li>• Tribal ID with name, address, photo and signature.</li><li>• Photo ID and a document with current name and address</li></ul> <p><i>The ID can be expired.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Driver's license, state ID or learner's permit issued by any state</li><li>• U.S. Passport</li><li>• U.S. Military or Veteran ID</li><li>• Tribal ID with name, signature and photo</li><li>• Minnesota university, college or technical college ID</li><li>• Minnesota high school ID</li></ul> <p>APPROVED DOCUMENTS (CHOOSE ONE) <i>Can be shown on electronic device.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bill, account or start-of-service statement due or dated within 30 days of the election for:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Phone, TV or internet</li><li>◦ Solid waste, sewer, electric, gas or water</li><li>◦ Banking or credit card</li><li>◦ Rent or mortgage</li></ul></li><li>• Residential lease or rent agreement valid through Election Day</li><li>• Current student fee statement</li></ul>
