<p>On June 30, 2019, Delaware Governor John Carney (D) signed a bill that established in-person early voting beginning January 1, 2022.</p> <p>The law allows voters to vote "in-person during at least 10 days before an election, up to and including the Saturday and Sunday immediately before the election</p>	<p>To vote in Delaware, an individual must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● He or she must be a United States citizen.● He or she must be a resident of Delaware.● He or she must be 18 years of age by Election Day.● He or she must be mentally competent.● He or she must not be under a felony sentence or convicted of a disqualifying felony. <p>The deadline for registration is 24 days before an election. An eligible voter can register to vote by mail, by phone, or in person at the Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of Health and Social Services, or the Department of Labor.</p>	<p>Delaware requires voters to present non-photo identification while voting.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2021.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Delaware Drivers License or State ID● U. S. Passport● Signed Polling Place or Social Security Card● Signed vehicle registration● Signed credit card with photo● A similar document that identifies the person by photo or signature● Voters who do not present proof of identity can "sign an affidavit of affirmation that the voter is the person listed on the election district record," according to Delaware Code
