<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>May 10, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. (Central time zone); 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (Mountain time zone)[1]</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Each applicant must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of the Nebraska county in which they are registering, and at least 18 years old by the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.</li><li>● Citizens are eligible to register to vote on January 1 of the year they will turn 18 before the November general election.</li><li>● Individuals who have been convicted of a felony are ineligible to register to vote until two years after the terms of their sentence have been completed, and individuals who have been declared mentally incompetent by a court are ineligible to register to vote.</li><li>● A voter registration application can be completed in person at the county clerk or election commissioner's office, the Department of Motor Vehicles, or other state agencies.</li><li>● In-person registration must be completed by the second Friday preceding the election.</li><li>● Applications returned by mail must be postmarked by the third Friday before the election.</li><li>● Online applications must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on the third Friday before the election.</li></ul>	<p>Nebraska does not require voters to present identification while voting, in most cases. A first-time voter who registered by mail and did not provide identification will be asked for an ID on election day.</p>
