	<p>To register to vote in Virginia is the following criteria, according to the Virginia Department of Elections:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Be a resident of Virginia (a person who has come to Virginia for temporary purposes and intends to return to another state is not considered a resident for voting purposes).</li><li>● Be a U. S. Citizen.</li><li>● Be 18 years old (any person who is 17 years old and will be eighteen years of age at the next general election shall be permitted to register in advance and also vote in any intervening primary or special election).</li><li>● Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.</li><li>● Not currently declared mentally incompetent by a court of law.</li><li>● If convicted of a felony, your right to vote must have been restored.</li></ul> <p>Those without a valid Virginia Driver’s license or state ID can still vote by signing an ID statement affirming their identity or vote via provisional ballot.</p>	<p>Any voter who does not present acceptable identification may instead sign a statement, subject to felony penalties, that they are the named registered voter who they claim to be.</p> <p>The following documents were considered acceptable identification for voting as of May 2023:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Virginia driver's license or DMV-issued ID card</li><li>● Valid employee ID, containing a photo, issued by the voter's employer in ordinary course of business</li><li>● U.S. military ID</li><li>● Valid student ID, containing a photo, issued by any public or private school college, or university</li><li>● Valid student ID issued by a public or private school high school, college, or university in Virginia (with or without a photo)</li><li>● Valid U.S. passport or passport card</li><li>● ID card issued by the federal government or a Virginia state or local authority.</li><li>● Voter ID card issued by the department of elections</li><li>● Voter confirmation documents</li><li>● Valid tribal enrollment or ID issued by one of the 11 tribes recognized in Virginia</li><li>● Government nursing home resident ID</li><li>● Any other current government document containing the name and address of the voter</li><li>● Signed ID Confirmation Statement</li></ul>
