	<p><u>To register to vote in Arizona you must meet the following qualifications (A.R.S. § 16-101):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be a citizen of the United States of America• Be a resident of Arizona and the county listed on your registration• Be 18 years of age on or before the day of the next regular General Election <p><u>You cannot register to vote in Arizona if (A.R.S. § 16-101):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• You have been convicted of a felony and have not yet had your civil rights restored. For a first-time felony conviction, civil rights are automatically restored upon completion of a person's sentence and payment of any restitution.• You have been adjudicated incapacitated by a court of law.	<p>Arizona requires voters to present photo identification or two forms of non-photo identification (ID) while voting.</p> <p>Accepted forms of photo ID include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• driver's licenses,• Arizona ID cards, and• U.S. government-issued IDs. <p>Accepted forms of non-photo ID include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• utility bills,• bank statements, and• valid Arizona vehicle registration documents containing the voter's name and address.
