### REGISTRATION RULES

To register to vote in Florida, you must:

- 1. Be a Citizen of the United States of America
- 2. Be a Florida resident;
- Be at least 18 years old);
- Not have been adjudicated mentally incapacitated with respect to voting in Florida or any other state without having the right to vote restored;
- 5. Not have been convicted of a felony without your voting rights having been restored.

Florida requires voters to present photo identification with a signature while voting.

**KEY ID REQUIREMENTS SOURCES** 

The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2023.

- Florida driver's license
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- United States passport
- Debit or credit card
- Military identification
- Student identification
- Retirement center identification
- Neighborhood association identification
- Public assistance identification
- Veteran health identification card issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- License to carry a concealed weapon or firearm issued pursuant to s. 790.06
- Employee identification card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the federal government, the state, a county, or a municipality

A voter who presents an ID without a signature must show a second form of identification that includes the voter's signature.
