	<p>To <u>register</u> to vote in the state of Washington, you must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● A citizen of the United States● A legal resident of Washington state for at least 30 days prior to election day● At least 18 years old<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ If you are 16 or 17, you can sign up as a <u>Future Voter</u> and be automatically registered to vote when you qualify● Not disqualified from voting due to a court order● Not currently serving a sentence of total confinement in prison under the jurisdiction of the department of corrections for a Washington felony conviction● Not currently incarcerated for a federal or out-of-state felony conviction	<p>Most voters in Washington vote by mail, which does not require them to present photo identification (ID).</p> <p>However, according to state law RCW 29A.40.160, “The county auditor shall require any person desiring to vote at a voting center to either sign a ballot declaration or provide identification.” Accepted forms of ID include: driver's licenses, state ID cards, and student ID cards.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2023.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Driver's license● State identification card● Student identification card● Tribal identification card● Employer identification card
