|                   | <p>For any election, the last day to register to vote or update one's voter registration is the 15th day prior to the election.</p> <p>To submit an application to register to vote, one must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Must be a citizen of the United States.</li><li>● Must live in the State of Alabama.</li><li>● Must be at least 18 years of age on or before election day.</li><li>● Must not be barred from voting by reason of a disqualifying felony conviction.</li><li>● Must not have been judged "mentally incompetent" in a court of law.</li><li>● Will be required to present valid photo identification when you vote at your polling place or by absentee ballot, unless exempted by law.</li></ul> | <p><b>SUMMARY:</b> Accepted forms of ID include Alabama driver's licenses, different state-issued IDs, U.S. passports, and Alabama photo voter ID cards.</p> <p><b>DETAILS:</b> A voter can use any of the following forms of photo ID at polls:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Valid Driver's License (not expired or has been expired less than 60 days)</li><li>● Alabama Law Enforcement Agency Digital Driver's License</li><li>● Valid Non-driver ID (not expired or has been expired less than 60 days)</li><li>● Alabama Law Enforcement Agency Digital Non-driver ID</li><li>● Valid Alabama Photo Voter ID</li><li>● Valid State Issued ID (Alabama or any other state)</li><li>● Valid AL Department of Corrections Release- Temp ID (Photo Required)</li><li>● Valid AL Movement/Booking Sheet from Prison/Jail System -Photo</li><li>● Valid Pistol Permit (Photo Required)</li><li>● Valid Federal Issued ID e.g. valid US Passport</li><li>● Valid Employee ID from Federal Government, State of Alabama, County Government, Municipality, Board, Authority, or other entity of this state</li><li>● Valid student or employee ID from a college or university in the State of Alabama (including postgraduate technical or professional schools)</li><li>● Valid Military ID</li><li>● Valid Tribal ID</li><li>● A voter can obtain a free photo ID from the Alabama Secretary of State, a county registrar's office, or a mobile location</li></ul> |
