<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>June 14, 2022: Primary June 28, 2022: Primary runoff November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m</p>	<p>To register to vote in South Carolina, each applicant must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of the county and precinct in which he or she is registering, and at least 18 years old by the day of the next election.</p> <p>Individuals who have been declared mentally incompetent by court order, who are imprisoned, or who are serving sentences for a felony conviction are ineligible to register to vote.</p> <p>The deadline for registration is 30 days before the election. Prospective voters may register to vote online, in person at the county board of voter registration, or by downloading a voter registration form and mailing, faxing, or emailing it to the county board of voter registration.</p>	<p>South Carolina requires voters to present photo identification while voting.</p> <p>Voters can present the following forms of identification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● South Carolina driver's license</li><li>● South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles ID card</li><li>● South Carolina concealed weapons permit</li><li>● South Carolina voter registration card with photo</li><li>● United States Military ID, including all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card</li><li>● U.S. Passport and Passport ID Card</li></ul> <p>Voters can obtain a free photo ID from a local DMV office or a county voter registration and elections office.</p>
