<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>May 24, 2022: Primary</p> <p>June 21, 2022: Primary runoff</p> <p>November 8, 2022: General election</p>	<p>To vote in Arkansas, one must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Arkansas.</p> <p>A voter must be 18 years of age or older on or before Election Day.</p> <p>Registration must be completed no later than 30 days before the election in which a voter wishes to participate. Citizens may register to vote by mail or at one of the following locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● County clerk's office● State Revenue Office, Driver Services● Public library● Public assistance agency● Disability agency● Military recruitment office● Voter registration drive	<p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of October 2019.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Driver's license● Photo identification card● Concealed handgun carry license● United States passport● Employee badge or identification document issued by an accredited postsecondary education institution in the State of Arkansas● United States military identification document● Public assistance identification card if it has a photograph● Voter verification card as provided under Ark.
