<p>Statewide election dates</p> <p>June 14, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: Open between 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.; close between 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.</p>	<p>North Dakota is the only state that does not require voter registration.</p> <p>Although North Dakota was one of the first states to adopt voter registration prior to the turn of the century, it abolished it in 1951.</p> <p>North Dakota law still provides cities with the ability to register voters for city elections.</p>	<p>North Dakota requires voters to present identification while voting. Identification must include the voter's name, current North Dakota residential address, and date of birth.</p> <p>Voters can present the following forms of information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Driver's license</li><li>● Non Driver's identification card</li><li>● Long-term care identification certificate</li></ul> <p>If a voter does not have a form of identification that includes his or her current North Dakota residential address or date of birth, the voter can present:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Current utility bill</li><li>● Current bank statement</li><li>● Check or a document issued by a federal, state, local, or tribal government that sets forth the tribal member's name, date of birth, and current North Dakota residential address)</li><li>● Paycheck</li></ul>
