	<p>To register to vote in New Mexico, each applicant must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● a citizen of the United States,● a resident of New Mexico, and● at least 18 years old by the time of the next election.● People convicted of a felony are eligible to vote after their prison time is completed, even if they are still on probation, parole, or another form of supervised release.● Individuals who have been declared mentally incapacitated may not register to vote.	<p>New Mexico does not require voters to present identification while voting, in most cases. However, if an individual registered to vote for the first time by mail and did not provide verification of his or her identity then, the voter will have to show identification.</p> <p>Those voters can present the following forms of identification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Current and valid photo identification● Current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, student identification card, or other government document, including identification issued by an Indian nation, tribe, or pueblo that shows the voter’s name and current address <p>Some municipalities require identification when voting in local elections.</p>
