Photo ID laws enacted in 2018 and 2019 will be implemented moving forward, starting with the municipal elections in September, October, and November 2023.  IDs that must be valid and unexpired, or expired for less than a year:  NC driver's license  Driver's license from another state (only accepted if voter registered with 90 days of the election)  Nonoperators ID card  NC voter photo ID card  NC voter photo ID card  Student ID card issued by an eligible NC university or community college  Employee ID card issued by a state or local government entity (including schools)  U.S. military ID card  U.S. Veterans ID card issued  Tribal enrollment card issued by a state or federally recognized tribe.  Public assistance ID card issued by a U.S. department, agency, or entity
