	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The constitutional qualifications to vote in Kansas are:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ (1) eighteen years of age or older,○ (2) U.S. citizenship, and○ (3) residency in Kansas. There is no length of residency requirement in Kansas, other than the 20 days one must be registered before the election	<p>In order to vote on Election Day in Kansas, a valid form of photo identification is required. A photo ID does not need to have an expiration date, but, if it does have an expiration date, it must not have expired at the time of voting.</p> <p>If the voter is over the age of 65, he or she can use an expired ID. Some voters are exempt from the photo ID requirement. Voters who do not have a photo ID can obtain one for free through the Division of Vehicles, Kansas Department of Revenue.</p> <p>Acceptable forms of photo ID include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A driver’s license or nondriver’s identification card issued by Kansas or by another state or district of the United States;• A concealed carry of handgun license issued by Kansas or a concealed carry of handgun or weapon license issued by another state or district of the United States;• A United States passport;• An employee badge or identification document issued by a municipal, county, state, or federal government office;• A military identification document issued by the United States;• A student identification card issued by an accredited postsecondary institution of education in the state of Kansas;• A public assistance identification card issued by a municipal, county, state or federal government office; and• An identification card issued by an Indian tribe
