	<p>To register (or pre-register) to vote, you must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● A citizen of the United States● A resident of the Rhode Island city or town where you wish to vote● At least 16 years of age (but you must be at least 18 years of age to vote.) <p>You may not register to vote if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● There is a written court order stating that you cannot vote. (If you have a legal guardian, you can vote unless the guardianship order specifically suspends your right to vote.)● You are incarcerated in a correctional facility upon a felony conviction. Once out of prison, your voting rights will automatically be restored if you were registered to vote when you entered the correctional facility. If you were not registered, you can exercise your right to vote by either notifying your local board of canvassers in writing or by submitting a new voter registration form.	<p>Any person claiming to be a registered and eligible voter who desires to vote at a primary election, special election, or general election shall provide proof of identity.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2023:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● RI Driver's License or Permit● RI Voter ID Card● U.S. Passport● ID issued by a U.S. educational institution● U.S. military ID● ID card issued by the United States or the State of Rhode Island● Government issued medical card● Tribal ID
