	<p>To be eligible to vote in Vermont, you must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be a citizen of the United States• Be a resident of Vermont in the town where your residential address is, or be a military or overseas voter whose last US residence was in Vermont• Take, or have previously taken the Voter’s Oath• Be 18 or older on Election Day	<p>Vermont does not require voters to present identification while voting in most cases. However, first-time voters who registered by mail are required to present identification at the polls.</p> <p>The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2023.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Valid photo ID (driver’s license or passport)• Current utility bill• Current bank statement• Another government document containing your residential address
