BASIC VOTING LAWS

REGISTRATION LAWS

To be eligible to vote in Vermont, you must:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of Vermont in the town where your residential address is, or be a military or overseas voter whose last US residence was in Vermont
- Take, or have previously taken the Voter's Oath
- Be 18 or older on Election Day

VOTER ID LAWS

Vermont does not require voters to present identification while voting in most cases. However, first-time voters who registered by mail are required to present identification at the polls.

The following list of accepted ID was current as of April 2023.

- Valid photo ID (driver's license or passport)
- Current utility bill
- Current bank statement
- Another government document containing your residential address
