	<ul> <li>Qualifications to Register to Vote <ul> <li>be a United States citizen;</li> <li>be 18 years old (you may pre-register at 16 or 17 but cannot vote until you are 18);</li> <li>resident of this state and the county, city or village for at least 30 days before the election;</li> <li>not be in prison for a felony conviction;</li> <li>not be adjudged mentally incompetent by a court;</li> <li>not claim the right to vote elsewhere.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>New York does not require voters to present identification while voting. However, if a voter does not provide valid identification at the time of registration, he or she must show identification at the polling place when voting for the first time.</li> <li>Voters can present the following forms of identification: <ul> <li>A current, valid photo ID, including but not limited to a drivers' license or a DMV-issued non-driver photo ID</li> <li>A current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document with the voter's name and address</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
