	<p>To vote in Missouri, one must be 18 years old, a United States citizen, and Missouri resident.</p> <p>An applicant may print an application, pick one up from a county clerk's office, or request that an application be mailed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The completed application must be returned by mail. All returned applications must be postmarked at least 27 days prior to Election Day in order to be processed.</li></ul> <p>An applicant may also register to vote online.</p>	<p>Missouri requires voters to present identification while voting. Identification with or without a photo can be used.</p> <p>The following were accepted forms of identification as of October 2019.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Non Expired Missouri driver’s license</li><li>• Non Expired or non expiring Missouri non-driver license</li><li>• Non Expired or non expiring military ID card with a photograph</li><li>• Identification issued by Missouri governments</li><li>• Identification issued by the United States government</li><li>• ID issued by an institution of higher education</li><li>• Copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or other government document that contains the name and address of the voter</li><li>• If a voter does not have an ID, he or she can obtain one for free</li></ul>
