<p>Statewide election dates August 2, 2022: Primary November 8, 2022: General election</p> <p>Polling hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.</p>	<p>To vote in Kansas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● one must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Kansas.</li></ul> <p>In order to register:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● an individual must be least 18 years old before the next election.</li><li>● Voters must register at least 21 days prior to Election Day.</li><li>● Registration can be done by completing and returning an application, either in person or by mail.</li><li>● Registration may also be completed online.</li></ul>	<p>Voters can present the following forms of identification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Driver's license or non driver's identification card issued by Kansas or by another state or district</li><li>● Concealed carry of handgun license issued by Kansas or another state</li><li>● United States passport</li><li>● Employee badge or identification document issued by a government.</li><li>● Military identification document</li><li>● Student identification card issued by an accredited postsecondary institution of education in the state of Kansas</li><li>● Public assistance identification card</li><li>● ID card issued by an Indian tribe</li></ul>
