You alone made every person in your divine image and likeness and deemed them worthy of love, respect, dignity, and honor. You, alone, expressed your redeeming love by placing humankind on such an exquisite and breathlessly beautiful earth and charging them to steward your world in righteousness and love. Let Us Pray

Jesus, you are the Great Physician, so we ask you to heal our sin-sick nation, grant America in November free, fair, and safe elections, and stand firmly against those who would destroy our very democracy. Let Us Pray

Effective prayers essentially have three prerequisites. The first is we must pray the Word of God. The bible says that His Word won't return to Him void but it will accomplish what it was sent for. This means that whatever God says will happen. His word will be fulfilled and will not return empty-handed. God is not obligated to respond to our words, but He responds to His own. So when we pray His Word, we can expect God to hear our prayer and His word to be accomplished. We know according to God's word that He hears our prayers. Isaiah 65:24 – Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear. Again, as we pray His word He will answer.

Secondly, we must pray in faith. Matthew 21:22 (AMP) “And whatever you ask for in prayer, believing, you will receive.” When we pray in faith believing that God hears us and will answer God will perform His word.

Fasting & Prayer

Thirdly, we must be on one accord. The bible tells us that when we are on one accord that God will answer our prayers." Again I say to you, that if two believers on earth agree [that is, are of one mind, in harmony] about anything that they ask [within the will of God], it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. Matthew 18:19 (AMP) Therefore, as we journey together for the next 40 days, we believe that when we focus on God, on one accord that God will answer our prayers. James 5:16 (NIV) Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. Additionally, we see throughout scripture where God hears the cry of His people and responds. Exodus 3:7-8 (AMP) The Lord said, "I have in fact seen the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I know their pain and suffering. 8 So I have come down to rescue them . . ."

Fasting & Prayer

God has given His people power through Jesus Christ, so we have the authority to call things into being. Matthew 16:19 (AMP) I will give you the keys (authority) of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth will have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on earth will have [already] been loosed in heaven." As referred to in Job 22:27-28, "You shall also declare and decree a thing, and it shall be established for you; and the light of God's favor shall shine upon your ways."

As we band together, we will call the Will of God to manifest on earth and come against any works of the enemy that will seek to derail it through deceit. The Holy Spirit reveals to us the Word we "decide to pray", which will give us the victory in Jesus! God has given us the authority to call thing into the earth that has already been established in heaven. Prayer Focus

Fasting and Prayer is not a religion, it is a spiritual lifestyle. Fasting combined with prayer gives you divine access to God, advantage over the enemy, and puts you in proper position for a breakthrough from God. It also produces great spiritual results. Each day as you meditate on the suggested focus theme and scripture, take a moment to go before the Lord in prayer and agreement by faith that God hears your earnest prayer. Also, take the time to journal your thoughts.

There are options during these 40-Days for how to fast. We recognize that you may be under medical supervision, so we ask that you consult with your physician prior to beginning. Commit to a particular fast that best works for you. Do not decide on a day-to-day basis. The fast can be Here are ways to fast:

Normal Fast – water or juice, but no food

Daniel Fast – water, fruits, grains, legumes, and vegetables

Financial Fast – limit unnecessary spending

Media/TV Fast – limit your consumption of television, internet and radio media

Social Fast – avoid negative discussions or engagement

Fasting & Prayer Instructions

DANIEL FAST

One of the great things about the Daniel Fast is that you are not limited to any specific amount of food but rather to the kinds of food you can eat.

FOODS TO INCLUDE IN YOUR DIET DURING THE DANIEL FAST

All fruit – fresh, frozen, dried, juiced, or canned

All vegetables – fresh, frozen, dried, juiced, or canned

All whole grains – barley, brown rice, oats, quinoa, millet, and whole wheat

All nuts & seeds – almonds, cashews, macadamia nuts, peanuts, pecans, pine nuts, walnuts, pumpkin seeds, sesame seeds, and sunflower seeds

All legumes – canned or dried; black beans, black-eyed peas, cannellini beans, garbanzo beans (chickpeas), great northern beans, kidney beans, lentils, pinto beans, and split peas.

All quality oils – avocado, coconut, grapeseed, olive, peanut, sesame, and walnut.

Beverages– distilled water, filtered water, spring water, fresh fruit or vegetable juices, unsweetened almond milk, coconut milk, rice milk, or soy milk

Other: tofu, soy products, vinegar, seasonings, salt, herbs and spices



**Fasting Food
Options**

FOODS TO AVOID ON THE DANIEL FAST

All meat and animal products – bacon, beef, buffalo, eggs, fish, lamb, poultry and pork

All dairy products – butter, cheese, cream, milk, and yogurt

All sweeteners – agave nectar, artificial sweeteners, brown rice syrup, can juice, honey, molasses, raw sugar, syrups, and sugar

All leavened bread & yeast – baked goods, and Ezekial bread

All refined/processed food products – artificial flavorings, chemicals, food additives, preservatives, white flour, and white rice

All deep-fried foods – corn chips, French fries, and potato chips

All solid fats – lard, margarine, and shortening

All desserts – sweets, candy, cakes, pies

Beverages: coffee, tea, herbal teas, energy drinks, carbonated beverages and alcohol.

Calling a Sacred Assembly

Joel 1:13-14

13 Put on sackcloth, you priests, and mourn; wail, you who minister before the altar. Come, spend the night in sackcloth, you who minister before my God; for the grain offerings and drink offerings are withheld from the house of your God. 14 Declare a holy fast; call a sacred assembly. Summon the elders and all who live in the land to the house of the Lord your God, and cry out to the Lord.

Day 1

Seeking God in Times of Trouble

Psalm 46:1-7

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. 2 Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; 3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. 4 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. 5 God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early. 6 The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, the earth melted. 7 The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

Day 2

Recovery for Our Nation

Jeremiah 8:20-22

20 The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved. 21 For the hurt of the daughter of my people am I hurt; I am black; astonishment hath taken hold on me. 22 Is there no balm in Gilead; is there no physician there? Why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?

Day 3

Hope in the Lord

Psalm 37:7-9

7 Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. 8 Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret—it leads only to evil. 9 For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the Lord will inherit the land.

Day 4

God's Requirement of Us

Micah 6:8

8 He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.

Day 5

God Is Our Helper

Isaiah 41:10

10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness

Day 6

Peace and Safety for Voters on Election Day (Poll workers)

Ephesians 6:10-13

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

Day 7

Finding Rest in God

Matthew 11:28-30

Day 8

Galatians 6:9-10

Day 9

2 Chronicles 20:1-4

It happened after this that the people of Moab with the people of Ammon, and others with them besides the Ammonites, came to battle against Jehoshaphat. 2 Then some came and told Jehoshaphat, saying, "A great multitude is coming against you from beyond the sea, from Syria; and they are in Hazazon Tamar." 3 And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the Lord, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. 4 So Judah gathered together to ask help from the Lord; and from all the cities of Judah they came to seek the Lord.

Day 28

God's Got This

2 Chronicles 20:14-17

14 Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly. 15 And he said, "Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the Lord to you: 'Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's. 16 Tomorrow go down against them. They will surely come up by the Ascent of Ziz, and you will find them at the end of the brook before the Wilderness of Jeruel. 17 You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!' Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you."

Mark 4:36-41

36 Now when they had left the multitude, they took Him along in the boat as He was. And other little boats were also with Him. 37 And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. 38 But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" 39 Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. 40 But He said to them, "Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?" 41 And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, "Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!"

Day 30

A Just and Awesome God

Deuteronomy 10:17-21

17 For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who is not partial and takes no bribe, 18 who executes justice for the orphan and the widow, and who loves the strangers, providing them food and clothing. 19 You shall also love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt. 20 You shall fear the Lord your God; him alone you shall worship; to him you shall hold fast, and by his name you shall swear. 21 He is your praise; he is your God, who has done for you these great and awesome things that your own eyes have seen.

Day 31

The Promise of Joy

Psalm 30:4-5

4 Sing praises to the Lord, O you his faithful ones, and give thanks to his holy name. 5 For his anger is but for a moment; his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may linger for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

Day 32

Rise Up and Stand Firm

Psalm 20:6-9

6 Now this I know: The Lord gives victory to his anointed. He answers him from his heavenly sanctuary with the victorious power of his right hand. 7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God. 8 They are brought to their knees and fall, but we rise up and stand firm. 9 Lord, give victory to the king! Answer us when we call!

Day 33

Renewed Strength

Isaiah 40:27-31

27 Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel, “My way is hidden from the Lord, and my right is disregarded by my God”? 28 Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. 29 He gives power to the faint, and strengthens the powerless. 30 Even youths will faint and be weary, and the young will fall exhausted; 31 but those who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Day 34

Resist and Persist

1 Peter 5:6-11

6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. 7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. 8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. 9 Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. 10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. 11 To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen.

Day 35

Sustained by Hope

Romans 5:1-5

1Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand; and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. 3 And not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, 5 and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

Day 36

God Strengthens and Protects Us

2 Thessalonians 3:1-5
